Definitions

Report: A Power BI report offers a multi-perspective view into a dataset with various visuals (charts, texts, values) to show different insights. Reports are more detailed than dashboards and allow users to drill down and filter data based on specific criteria.

Dashboard: Power BI Dashboard uses visualisations to narrate a compelling story by highlighting the most important insights across datasets, usually centred around key performance indicators (KPIs).
